

PROPOSITION W - APRIL 2, 2024

WASTEWATER



MSD Project Clear is in the midst of a \$7.2 billion, 28-year improvement program through 2039, part of an agreement with EPA and the Missouri Coalition for the Environment. These improvements are on schedule and on budget.

PROPOSITION W will decide whether MSDPC will issue bonds, borrowing part of funds needed for the next four years of required wastewater system improvements, which will protect more households from sewage backups and more sewage from entering creeks and streams. This question only asks voters how to fund these improvements.

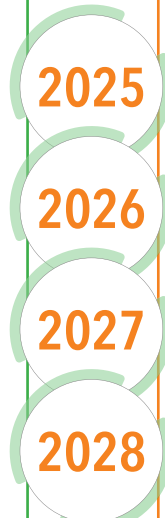
A "YES" VOTE



MSDPC will sell bonds and spread out the cost of the work. Like a home loan, it means you pay less now, but more over the long term.

A "NO" VOTE



MSDPC will pay with current revenues, resulting in higher monthly bill increases, but less cost in the long term.
